Pylon Premier Tackle Football 2025 Official Rules & Regulations

I: Game Play & Structure

Rule Format: All games follow NCAA rules with Pylon-specific modifications listed below.

If not stated, standard NCAA rules apply, including overtime.

- Game Length: Four (4) 10-minute regulation quarters for all age divisions.
- Timeouts: Each team receives 3 timeouts per half.
- Coaches on Field:
 - > 6U Division: One (1) offensive and one (1) defensive coach allowed on the field.
 - > All Other Divisions: Coaches must remain on the sideline.
- Special Teams:
 - 6U & 7U: No live punts. All punts are 30-yard walk-offs. If 30 yards can't be walked off, the result is a touchback.
 - > **8U–14U**: Live punts and PATs follow NCAA rules.
 - Field Goals & Extra Points (6U/7U): Protected kicks no defensive rush allowed.
- QB Protection (6U/7U):
 - Under Center: Defense may line up over center.
 - Shotgun/Pistol: No direct alignment over center or A gaps.
 - A-gap blitzing must start 3 yards back from the line of scrimmage.
- Kickoffs:
 - > 6U & 7U: From the 50-yard line.
 - > **8U–14U**: From the 35-yard line.
- Game Ball Requirements:
 - Must be leather (no composite or rubber).
 - Teams must provide their own ball or face penalties (7-0 deficit after 5 mins; forfeit after 10 mins).

- Minimum Ball Sizes:
 - 6U–9U: K2
 - 10U–11U: TDJ
 - 12U–14U: TDY
- Mercy Rule: Running clock begins with a 20-point lead. Regular clock resumes if margin drops below 20.

II: Rosters & Eligibility

- Rosters:
 - Fall roster only. No all-star or spring teams permitted.
 - Players must be locked into one age level/team as of August 15, 2025 (12:00
 AM).
- Eligibility:
 - Players must compete in a minimum of 4 games (13U/14U) or 6 games (6U– 12U) during the fall.
 - No high school players allowed. Once a player has completed 8th grade, they're ineligible.
 - 8th graders on any high school roster are not eligible for Pylon Tackle.
- Age Cutoff: July 1, 2025 players age on this date determines their age group.
- **Roster Platform**: All rosters must be listed and certified on the **SportsThread** platform.

Player Certification Process:

- 1. Online Certification (SportsThread Age Verification).
- 2. On-Site Book Check (hard copies only).
- 3. Pre-Game Face Check with Pylon officials.

Required Documents:

- Sovernment-issued ID (physical only, no paper copies).
- Fall 2024 report card with name, grade, and address.
- Current player photo.

III: Sidelines, Security, & Conduct

- Sideline Access:
 - > Maximum of **10 sideline passes** per team (including all staff/volunteers).
 - > Sideline violations will cause game stoppage or forfeit if not resolved.

Game Day Protocol:

- Clear bag policy enforced for all individuals entering.
- No wagons or bagged canopies.
- > Down markers/chains will be operated by official event staff only.

Coach Requirements:

- All coaches must pass a background check to receive field access.
- Coaches must be listed in the official SportsThread roster.
- Media Access:
 - > All media must be **pre-approved 48 hours before the event**.
 - No same-day media access allowed.

IV: Zero Tolerance Policy

- Verbal or Physical Misconduct:
 - Immediate ejection and removal from the facility.
 - If the offender refuses to leave, the game is forfeited.
- Fighting or Altercations:
 - Lifetime ban from all Pylon events, including non-Pylon affiliated youth sports.

Cheating:

Subject to board review with penalties including disqualification or permanent bans.
